

TUSCParks has been approved to receive \$500 through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources – WILD School Site grant program. We are partnering with the Buckeye Career Center to build a Chimney Swift Tower at the Trenton Heritage Park.

Chimney Swifts are a threatened species in Tuscarawas County due to habitat loss. Considering that one family consisting of two parents and three offspring eat about 5000-6000 airborne insects a day, the birds play a very important role in our community. To increase their numbers, TUSCParks will utilize these funds to construct a 12-foot tall tower where the birds can nest this summer.
