### Commissioners Open Bids for Courthouse Exterior Lighting Project

During Monday's Commissioners Meeting on July 2<sup>nd</sup>, the Board opened bids for the Courthouse Exterior Lighting Project. The only bid received was that of Vincent Lighting Systems, a company who was hired to program and operate lighting for the Cleveland Cavaliers home games and watch parties, including the playoffs and NBA Finals for the 2016 NBA Season.

The Architect's estimate for the project was \$175,000.00 to \$200,000.00

Melinda Shah, of Schooley Caldwell and Associates, was present to read the bid of Vincent Lighting Systems:

- Base Bid: \$120,582.00
  - Unit 1: \$1,964.00
  - Unit 2: \$1,843.00
  - Alternate 1: \$10,288.00
  - Alternate 2: \$359.00
- Unit 1 involves 12 lights in the dormers, and discussions on whether the lights will be white or color changing lights.
  - Alternate 1 involves exterior lighting power poles and a ground box. The power and lighting poles would be used to light the courtyard. This would provide more outlets and resources to events in that take place in the courtyard that require electricity.
  - Alternate 2 involves color changing light fixtures, of which there are currently 6 lights inside the dome.

The bid was taken under advisement and will be reviewed by the Project Architect, the Office of Community and Economic Development, and Legal Counsel. A decision by the Board will be made during an upcoming Commissioners Meeting.
