Centerline Striping, Railroad Markings, Coming to County Roads and Crossings

There will be some road and railroad crossing work coming to Tuscarawas County roads this year. On June 6th, the Commissioners approved the legal advertisement for Engineer Project #3-2018 TUS VAR PM (Pavement Markings) Phase 3. This project consists of centerline striping 194.16 miles of county roads throughout Tuscarawas County in two parts and marking twenty-eight Railroad Symbols at fifteen crossings. During the budgetary process in January, the Commissioners provided a grant of \$100,000.00 for this project.

Commissioner Metzger noted that the addition of this grant will allow the County Engineer to center stripe 194.16 miles of Tuscarawas County roads, which is approximately 42% of the entire county road system. Commissioner Metzger also noted that it has been years since the railroad crossing markings have been upgraded. Commissioner Abbuhl stated that “this project will assist the Engineer in making a significant impact on the safety of our county roadway system.”

The bid opening for Engineer project #3-2018 TUS VAR PM Phase 3 will be Monday, July 16th, 2018, at 9:30 a.m.
