Commissioners Hold Annual Fair Meeting

On Monday, September 17th, 2018, the Tuscarawas County Board of Commissioners held their annual Commissioners Fairgrounds Meeting at the Cloverleaf Café. Several different items were on Monday's agenda, such as a number of before/after expenditures, supplemental appropriations, transfer of funds, requests from the Tuscarawas County Metropolitan Sewer District and the Tuscarawas County Coroner's Office, to attend different out of county conferences. During Monday's session, the Commissioners also approved two change orders for Engineer Project 2-2018 Roadway Reprofiling and Resurfacing:

- Part 3 CR 52 Crooked Run Road – a net deduct of \$1,235.00
- Part 4 CR 98 Cherry Run Road – a net add of \$350.60

Amy Miller, of the Fair Board and Prosecutor's Office, also provided the Board with several updates at the fairgrounds this year:

- A new 40 feet by 80 feet multipurpose pavilion used for poultry at this year's fair – paid entirely through private donations and business vendors
- Newly installed LED Lights at the Four-Way Barn and Kiddy Land
- New electrical wiring in the beef and sheep barn
- Newly installed air conditioning in the Cloverleaf Café
- A new partnerships with Durant Amusements, which has updated rides and enhanced the appearance of the Midway

Noting all these improvements, Amy Miller was excited to add the Fair Board is trying to elevate and evolve the Tuscarawas County Fairgrounds into a community center for all of Tuscarawas County.

Commissioner Metzger thanked the Fair Board, expressing a deep gratitude for everything they do for the Tuscarawas County Fair. Commissioner Abbuhl reiterated that gratitude to the Fair Board for all their work, adding that he often hears other government officials throughout the state of Ohio note the Tuscarawas County Fair as one of the premiere fairs in Ohio. Commissioner Sciarretti echoed the thoughts of Commissioner Metzger and Commissioner Abbuhl, also noting that the fair is a quintessential event of Tuscarawas County, and that he appreciates the long standing trusting relationship between the Commissioners and Fair Board.
