On Friday May 9, 2008 at approximately 2:36 AM Tuscarawas County Sheriff's Deputies responded to several 911 calls regarding a reported assault and a female breaking out windows at 1338 Baltzley Valley Road S.E. New Philadelphia. As a result of the investigation by deputies Aric C. Fox (30) and Jason A. Kenosky (31) both of 1338 Baltzley Rd. S.E. were arrested for Assault on a female who was at the residence. The female was transported to Union Hospital by ambulance for injuries she stated were sustained from Fox and Kenosky and has since been released.

Deputies notified Tuscarawas County Sheriff's Detectives for assistance due to a strong odor of what was believed to be marijuana coming from inside the residence. After obtaining a Search Warrant deputies were able to seize 98 marijuana plants along with drug paraphernalia as well as growing lights and equipment from the home. Two K-9's were removed from the home by the Tuscarawas County Dog Warden.

Aric C. Fox and Jason A. Kenosky are currently being held in the Tuscarawas County Jail pending the expected filing of Felony charges of possession and cultivation of drugs for the marijuana grow operation. Fox and Kenosky were served with charges for the assault as well as protection orders filed by the injured female.
