Drug House Raid 764 Stone Creek Rd. SW

On Monday March 16, 2009 Tuscarawas County L.E.A.D. Drug Task Force Detectives and Tuscarawas County Sheriff's Office SWAT team members raided a suspected drug house located at 764 Stonecreek Rd SW in York Township. A total of 146 suspected marijuana plants, grow material and assorted prescription and non prescription pills along with two handguns were seized from the residence. Also a large amount of cash, foreign documents and a Pit Bull dog with a puppy were located at the residence.

Detectives took into custody, Julio De Leon (33) and Ramon Macario Tol (37) who reside at the residence. Both are expected to be charged with Marijuana Cultivation and Possession of Narcotics with information sent to Immigration Customs Enforcement (ICE) for further investigation regarding their status as to being in the United States. Both are currently being held in the Tuscarawas County Jail pending formal charges.

L.E.A.D. Detcetives had been looking into the possibility of the home being a drug house for several weeks with investigation finally leading to a Search Warrant.

Dover Police, the Tuscarawas County Dog Warden, a Tuscarawas County Sheriff's K9 unit and Carroll County Sheriff's Narcotics Detectives assisted with the raid and investigation.
