Robbery Indictment Served

On Friday October 29, 2010 L.E.A.D. Detectives served a Tuscarawas County Grand Jury Warrant on Indictment to Jeffrey S. Hagar (30) of 306 9th Street Cambridge for one third degree felony count of Robbery.

The Indictment is the direct result of an undercover drug investigation that began this past summer in the Stonecreek when detectives received information that Hagar was allegedly bringing large quantities of prescription pills into Tuscarawas County selling them to a certain individual who would meet him in rural areas.

Detectives were able to set up a controlled undercover buy with Hagar in the Stonecreek area through a confidential informant. When Hagar met with the informant he became physically aggressive subsequently robbing the operative of the money provided by detectives for the purpose of purchasing pills from him. Detectives were able to apprehend Hagar after a very brief pursuit taking him into custody.

Guernsey County Sheriff's Detectives along with an agent from the Adult Parole Authority and a trooper from the Ohio Highway Patrol assisted L.E.A.D. Detectives with the investigation.

Hagar is incarcerated in the Tuscarawas Count Jail pending Arraignment in Common Pleas Court.
