Meth Lab located in New Philadelphia

The New Philadelphia Police Department located a Meth Lab at the residence of Robert B. Miller (49) of 208 St. Clair Ave SW. Miller was found to be manufacturing Methamphetamine out of an upstairs bedroom. Officers then contacted a Clandestine Recovery and Disposal team to dispose of the dangerous chemicals and paraphernalia. Miller is currently on probation for possession of Methamphetamine and is being held at the Tuscarawas County jail.

Assisting in the investigation, recovery and disposal of the lab was the State of Ohio Adult Parole Authority, New Philadelphia P.D., L.E.A.D., local D.E.A., Summit County Drug Unit and Chemical Pack Services.

Methamphetamine is an illegal synthetic drug commonly known as Meth, Crystal Meth, Ice and Crank. Meth effects the central nervous system having similar effects of cocaine.
