Two Arrested in Newcomerstown For Drug Trafficking

On Wednesday August 4, 2010 Newcomerstown Police along with a detective from the L.E.A.D. Task Force served two Tuscarawas County Grand Jury Indictments for felony Trafficking in Drugs on Nicholas L. Millender (37) of 624 Wood Ave. and his brother Domonique L. Millender (30) Of 118 N. Bridge Street in Newcomerstown.

The two have been the focus of a lengthy investigation involving trafficking in illegal narcotics in the Village of Newcomerstown as well as Oxford Township in Tuscarawas County and eastern Coshocton county. L.E.A.D detectives credit the arrests to Newcomerstown Police Chief Gary Holland as well as task force contact officer Bryan Eubanks.

Both have proven to be very proactive while working with the county drug task force.

Undercover controlled drug buys were conducted on Nicholas Millender with purchases and deliveries of Cocaine, Oxycodone powder and a counterfeit substance that was sold as a narcotic.

Undercover controlled drug buys were also conducted on Domonique Millender for sales and deliveries of Cocaine and a counterfeit substance sold as Cocaine.

Both men are being held in the Tuscarawas County Jail pending arraignment in Tuscarawas County Common Pleas Court.
