Local man indicted on drug charges.

On Friday March 16, 2012 30 year old Andrew Napier of 2487 Johnstown Rd, N.E. Dover, Ohio was served a summons on indictment for 3 felony counts of Possession of Drugs and 1 misdemeanor count of Permitting Drug Abuse.

On May 10, 2011 the Multi Jurisdictional L.E.A.D. Task Force Detectives along with New Philadelphia Police executed a Search Warrant at Andrew Napier's form residence, 1313 5th St. N.W. New Philadelphia.

The case began when Dover Police Officer William Nedrow reported to New Philadelphia Police that Napier had dropped off an unidentified male at the Union Hospital Emergency Room for a possible drug overdose. Officer Nedrow requested New Phila officers to check Napier's residence for any identification of the unidentified male. The information obtained resulted in a Search Warrant being served on Napier's residence, 1313 5th St. N.W. Evidence located in the house was prescription narcotics, hypodermic syringes, spoons with drug residue and other drug paraphernalia. Officer's also located evidence of a Marihuana grow in the basement of Napier's home.

Napier is scheduled for appearance on March 22, 2012 at 12:45pm. and is expected to plead to a Bill of Information regarding the charges.
