Drug Trafficking Arrest

On Wednesday June 5, 2013 New Philadelphia Police and Multi- County L.E.A.D. Detectives arrested David J. Martin (27) of 816 Maple Ave. NE New Philadelphia at his residence on a Tuscarawas County Grand Jury Indictment for two felony counts of Trafficking in Drugs. One count is a fifth degree felony and the other is a felony of the fourth degree due to the deal taking place within 1000 feet of a school.

Detectives began the investigation after receiving information that Martin may be conducting illegal drug sales at his residence located directly across the street from West Elementary in New Philadelphia. Investigators observed a great deal of suspicious activity with a lot of traffic in and out of the residence and were eventually able to coordinate and complete two undercover buys of marijuana from Martin with one of the transactions occurring at his residence.

David Martin was transported to the Tuscarawas County Jail and he will remain there until his arraignment in Common Pleas Court at a later date and time.
