Tuscarawas County Sheriff's Office Offers Safe and Legal Way to Dispose of Prescription Medications

The Tuscarawas County Sheriff's Office wishes to remind the public that our office offers a safe and legal way to dispose of expired or unused prescription medications with no questions asked. Located in the lobby of the Tuscarawas County Sheriff's Office is a mailbox-style bin that allows the public to dispose of outdated and unneeded prescription medications such as pills, capsules and patches. However, liquids and needles cannot be disposed. Our lobby is open 24 hours a day including weekends and holidays so the public can remove expired or unused prescription medications from their homes at their convenience instead of having to wait for an announced disposal event.
